Why Recycle+?

Residential garbage and recycling collection customers now have the option to recycle even more with Recycle+, a new service from your garbage and recycling company.



How it works

Schedule

Recycle+ collections happen every-other week.

Your garbage and recycling hauler will confirm your collection date, which may not fall on the same day as your regular weekly service.

Haulers require notice of at least two-business days to schedule a collection.

Curbside rates

Customers will pay a monthly base fee of \$2.50 and a \$9.25 pick-up fee per collection.

If you have items that do not fit in the provided bags, haulers will still accept them. Place extras in 5-gallon bags next to your Recycle+ bin.

Extra bags are \$1 each, up to 5 extra bags per pick-up.

Block foam pick-up is \$9 per bag.

Get started

- 1. Contact your garbage and recycling company to sign up.
- 2. Sort and bag material by type.
- 3. Schedule a pick up.
- 4. Set your bin at the curb.

Prepare materials

You will receive a purple bin and plastic bags from your garbage hauler.

- Separate materials by type.
- Put the materials in the plastic bags provided.
- Place the bags in the purple bin.
- Container lid must close completely to keep materials dry.

Placement + service

On your service day, place your Recycle+ bin curbside by 6 a.m.

Compact fluorescent lightbulbs



- Fluorescent bulbs that are curved or folded to fit the space of a regular household lamp.
- Bulbs must be contained in a zip-sealed bag.
- ✗ Incandescent bulbs, halogen, LED bulbs, fluorescent tubes, broken light bulbs.

Textiles



- Clothing.
- Bed linens, pillowcases.
- Towels/rags.
- Shoes, pillows and cushions, wet or mildewed items, fabric with oil, gasoline or other hazardous materials.



Rotating item for reuse or recycling



Each quarter the program will feature a rotating item for reuse or recycling.



Stretchy plastic film/bags



- Soft, **stretchy** polyethylene (#2 PE and #4 LDPE) packaging free of food residue.
- Dry cleaning and produce bags.
- Plastic overwrap, air pillows.
 - Food-soiled or dirty film plastic, paper-padded envelopes, non-stretchy film or bags.



#1 Clamshells





- Clear #1 PET/PETE only.
- One-piece containers hinged on one side and stamped with #1 PET/PETE.
- Food residue, opaque plastic, trays, cups, bottles, non-hinged containers.



Styrofoam (extra charge)





Coolers and other protective packaging.

• White styrofoam (#6 PS) only.

Food residue, dirt or tape, packing peanuts, squishy foam
