OPTIONS

• Visit GreshamOregon.gov/Haulers-and-Rates for garbage collection rates and special services.

• **Garbage** and recycling is collected weekly in Gresham. Customers may select monthly service for certain container sizes.

• **Extra bag** or can of garbage or an extra can, kraft paper bag or bundle of yard debris can be set out for a fee. Extras must be 32 gallons or smaller and weigh 55 lbs. or less. Yard debris bundles must be no longer than 3 ft. in length and 18 in. in diameter.

• Large items too big for your garbage container can be collected for an extra charge. Call your garbage company to arrange pick up.

• **Inclement weather** may delay collection. Leave carts at the curb. If pick-up is missed, place bagged extra garbage, equal to your service level, at the curb following week at no additional cost.

• Set out all containers and roll carts by

- 6 a.m. Please remove within 24 hours of pick-up.
- **Place** containers at the curb, leave a space of 3 ft. between carts and 6 ft. from cars, mailboxes, basketball hoops, trees and other stationary objects.
- **Materials** should fit loosely in the roll cart with the lid closed and should fall freely when emptied.
- **Use** roll carts first, cans may be used for extra set outs for a fee.
