### Walk, bike, and roll safely to school

Gresham Safe Routes to School serves the diverse population of Gresham to make walking, biking, and rolling through our community to school active, safe, and fun.

This program provides schools, administrators, teachers, parents, and students with resources, incentives, and opportunities to incorporate active transportation to and from school.

### City of Gresham assistance for your school

Resources are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

**Event support.** This may include small incentives to hand out to participating students, promotional materials, and healthy snacks.

**Printing.** Help with developing and printing flyers, news releases, maps, posters, parent surveys, and permission forms.

**Encouragement activities.** Help organizing Walking School Buses, Bike Trains, and other fun activities that encourage active transportation to and from school.

**Action plans.** For schools who want to do more, the City can partner with you to develop an action plan for more involved engineering solutions to safe routes.
